In fulfilling this ambitious goal, the Reserve will span a multi-million acre area, created by purchasing private lands to connect a vast mosaic of existing public lands so that the region is managed thoughtfully and collaboratively for wildlife conservation and public access to be enjoyed forever and by all. In addition to providing the space and habitat needed to restore the natural abundance and diversity of wildlife in the region, American Prairie promotes social tolerance for prairie species such as bison, swift foxes, black-footed ferrets, prairie dogs, and grizzly bears.
